

Scholarships for apprenticeship as BTA at School of Life Science in Hamburg

Are you interested in training as a biological-technical assistant?

To support the next generation of scientists, altona Diagnostics is awarding two scholarships for students in the 2021 training year (start: August 2021) at the School of Life Science in Hamburg. The school is an enterprise of the renowned University Medical Center Hamburg-Eppendorf (UKE).
